# SI2817 SIMPLE CORDED TELEPHONE INSTRUCTION MANUAL

#### FUNCTIONS

- ➤ Last number redial
- > Pause
- > Flash
- > Mute
- ➢ Tone/Pulse dialing
- Ringer volume control (Hi/Lo)
- Receiver volume control

## MAKING A CALL

- 1. Lift the handset.
- 2. Wait for the dial tone and then dial the telephone

## LAST NUMBER REDIAL

- 1. To redial the last number called, lift the handset and press the (REDIAL) button. The number will be dialed automatically.
- 2. The number will be retained in memory until another number is dialed.

## PAUSE

For some network services such as home banking or PABX's which give a secondary dial tone before further dialing, it may be necessary to insert a pause between digits.

# FLASH

- 1. Press the (FLASH) button, the phone line will break and disconnected.
- 2. You can use this function to utilize the special services. (please consult your switching system provider for details)

### MUTE

Press and hold the (MUTE) button during the conversation, your voice will not pass through the microphone.

#### TONE / PULSE DIALING

Switch the Tone or Pulse to make a call on the base unit.

#### **RINGER VOLUME CONTROL**

Switch the ringer volume control on the base bottom to select the desired ringer volume level.

## **RECEIVER VOLUME CONTROL**

Press and hold the volume key on the handset to make the receiver volume louder during the conversation.

# MAINTENANCE

- Do not position in areas of high humidity, dust, high temperature, mechanical shock or strong sunlight.
- 2. Do not position in bathrooms or near water.
- 3. Do not disassemble this telephone, it contains no user-serviceable parts.
- 4. It is recommended to disconnected the telephone line from the wall socket during the thunderstorms, as lightning might seriously damage the telephone. The warranty does not cover damage caused by lightning.

## FAULT FINDING

- 1. Make sure all connection of coil cord and line cord are connected securely to the jacks.
- 2. Check the telephone operation in master telephone socket. There may be a fault with the line in which case contact your network operator.
- 3. If the telephone does not ring, lift and replace the handset, and make sure the ringer switch has switched in "HI" position.

## WALL MOUNTING

If you are wall mounting this telephone, the position of two holes is 96mm apart.
